



RESIDUAL STAIN REMOVER

PermaGo[®]

PermaGo removes residual ink, protein and tannin stains, as well as many other residual stains. PermaGo should only be used on white fabric and must be neutralized after use with either ColorGo® or ExGo®.

DIRECTIONS

Before starting, read and understand the a PermaGo Material Safety Data Sheet.

> For Small Stains:

Apply full strength PermaGo directly to stain. Wait one minute, then flush thoroughly with water. Apply ColorGo* full strength over the remaining PermaGo, moisten slightly and work in until PermaGo disappears. (To speed up neutralization of PermaGo, apply RustGo®on top of ColorGo and/or heat ColorGo with steam gun.) Rinse thoroughly after PermaGo disappears.

*ExGo can be used instead of ColorGo.

> For Large Area Stains:

Rinse fabric thoroughly with water and put aside. In a clean plastic container or stainless steel wash wheel, prepare enough PermaGo solution (2 oz. PermaGo for every gallon of 150-180°F water used) to allow free movement of fabric. Immerse fabric in PermaGo solution and agitate for 10 minutes. Rinse thoroughly with water. In a clean plastic container or stainless steel wash wheel, prepare enough ColorGo solution (2 oz. ColorGo for every gallon of 150-180°F water used) to allow free movement of fabric. Immerse fabric in ColorGo solution and agitate. (Heating the solution will increase its ability to neutralize PermaGo; boil if necessary.) Rinse thoroughly with water after PermaGo disappears. Follow with normal washing procedure.
